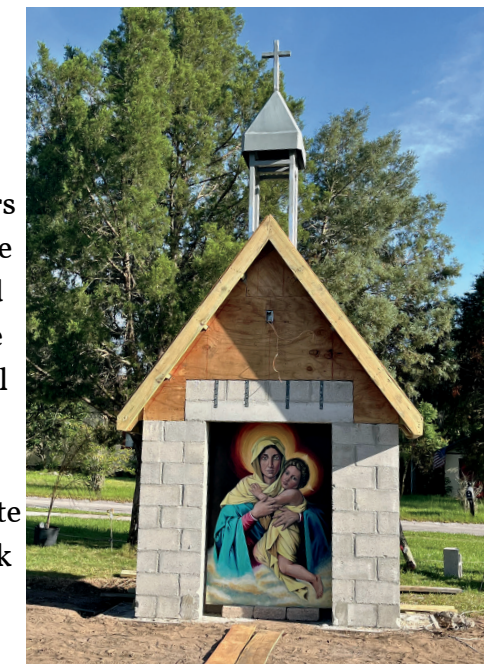
## Shrine Update

We are excited to share that work on the Shrine continues to progress beautifully.

The painting, which will serve as a focal point of the Shrine, now has over 130 hours of dedicated work invested in it and continues to take shape. At this time, we are awaiting the arrival of a custom ambo. The stone for this piece is being sourced from Italy, and we expect it will take a couple more months to arrive. While the Shrine structure itself should be completed within the next few weeks, the final installation of the altar, ambo, and surrounding brickwork will take place together once all materials have arrived.

Thank you for your patience, support, and continued prayers as we work to create this beautiful place of prayer and devotion to our Blessed Mother Mary. We look forward to sharing more updates with you in the coming months.
